Male Births Declining In The U.S.

The number of male babies born in the U.S. is dropping and has been on a steady decline for the last three decades, according to a new study.

Researchers found the decline in male births is equivalent to 135,000 fewer white males in the last 30 years in the U.S. They say the reason for the decrease is unclear, but environmental factors, coupled with the rising age of parents giving birth, may be playing a role.

"We know that men who work with some solvents, metals, and pesticides father fewer baby boys. We also know that nutritional factors, physical health, and chemical exposures

Everybody wants to know where all the men have gone. The *Washington Post* calls their disappearance the "question that has grown too conspicuous to ignore," and *USA Today* notes "universities fret about how to attract males as women increasingly dominate campuses."

Females now outnumber males by a four to three ratio in American colleges, a difference of almost two million students. Men earn only 43% of all college degrees. Among blacks, two women earn bachelor's degrees for every man. Among Hispanics, only 40 percent of college graduates are male. Female high school graduates are 16% more likely to go to college than their male counterparts.







There are 2 options. Death as a Christian or death as a non-Christian.

Death Before Christ's Resurrection

Luke 16: 19-26

“There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and lived in luxury every day. At his gate was laid a beggar named Lazarus, covered with sores and longing to eat what fell from the rich man’s table. Even the dogs came and licked his sores.





Summary-Old Testament Death

Old Testament Saints entered a paradise with Abraham when they died and are awaiting eternity in the new Heaven.

Summary-Christian Death

After Christ's resurrection we who are Christians will fall asleep and Jesus will welcome us into paradise awaiting the new Heaven which will be our eternal home.

Summary-Death without God

Those who died without God before Christ or without Christ after His resurrection will enter a place referred to as “Hades” which is a place of torment awaiting judgement before Jesus and then the final sentencing of eternity in Hell.

Summary-Death without God

There is also a place of torment for the spiritual world who stand against God. This place is called the Abyss. We discussed this previously.

Revelation 20: 11-15

Then I saw a great white throne and him who was seated on it. The earth and the heavens fled from his presence.

This is telling us that there will be nothing present but just Christ and those being judged.

What does it mean great and small?

From great and small means
from kings and presidents to
the poor and homeless.

John 5:24

Very truly I tell you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be judged but has crossed over from death to life.

Will Christians be judged?

Roman 8: 1-2

Therefore, there is now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus, because

through Christ Jesus the law of the Spirit who gives life has set you a free from the law of sin and death.

Great White Throne Judgement

Great White Throne Judgement

each person was judged according to what they had done... Anyone whose name was not found written in the book of life was thrown into the lake of fire.

Note: there are multiple books, not a single book. This is going to be very personal. Each person will appear singly before Christ, remember He has an eternity to do this. The Dead is a term used for those who are without Christ or without God.

Books

Psalm 69: 27-28

Charge them with crime upon crime; do not let them share in your salvation. May they be blotted out of the book of life and not be listed with the righteous.

Philippians 4:3

Yes, and I ask you, my true companion, help these women since they have contended at my side in the cause of the gospel, along with Clement and the rest of my co-workers, whose names are in the book of life.

Books

Revelation 3:5

The one who is victorious will, like them, be dressed in white. I will never blot out the name of that person from the book of life, but will acknowledge that name before my Father and his angels.

Books

Revelation 13:8

All inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast – all whose names have not been written in the Lamb's book of life, the Lamb who was slain from the creation of the world.

What is the book of life?

Upon conception God has created life and that life is so precious to God that He writes the name He has given each life He created in the book of life.

What is the book of life?

Everyone, regardless of their lifestyle and faith, has their name written in the book of life when they are created.

What is the Lamb's Book of Life?

When you become a Christian your name is then also written in the Lamb's book of life.

Books

In the end those whose name is not found written in the Lambs Book of Life will have their name blotted out of the Book of Life at their final judgement.

In other words they are considered by God to have never existed, they are remembered no more. They are blotted out. They are forgotten by all.


We will all stand before Christ.
