Daniel 12:8 (NASB)

As for me, I heard but could not understand; so I said, “My lord, what will be the outcome of these events?”

Daniel 12:9 (NASB)

He said, "Go your way, Daniel, for these words are concealed and sealed up until the end time.

Daniel 12:10 (NASB)

Many will be purged, purified and refined, but the wicked will act wickedly; and none of the wicked will understand, but those who have insight will understand.

Daniel 12:11 (NASB)

From the time that the regular sacrifice is abolished and the abomination of desolation is set up, there will be 1,290 days.

Multiple times God has told
us that the great
tribulation will last 1260
days, 42 months or time
times and half a time so
why now do we see an
additional 30 days or 1290
days until the end?

You have 1260 days until the end of the Tribulation, the return of Christ. And then apparently you have 30 days for the remaining purging.

Matthew 25: 31-33

“But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. All the nations will be gathered before Him

Matthew 25: 31-33

and He will separate them from one another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats; and He will put the sheep on His right, and the goats on the left.

Daniel 12:12 (NASB)

*How blessed is he who
keeps waiting and attains to
the 1,335 days!*

One possible explanation is that it will take an extra 45 days for the establishment of the Kingdom on Earth.

If you endure through the tribulation and after the 30 days of purging you are one of the sheep you will be blessed by entering into the Kingdom 1,335 days from the beginning of the Great Tribulation.

Daniel 12:13 (NASB)

But as for you, go your way to the end; then you will enter into rest and rise again for your allotted portion at the end of the age.”
