Matthew 5-7

Beatitudes Building Blocks Those who realize their spiritual position before a Holy God, will mourn due to their sin, will develop meekness and humility, will hunger and thirst for righteousness and will recognize their need for mercy from God and develop a deep desire to demonstrate that mercy to others.

Matthew 5: 8(NASB)

"Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.

What does it mean to be pure?

Pure

It is translated from the Greek word katharos which is a noun formed from kathariz, which means to cleanse from filth and iniquity.

Pure-Webster 1828

Free from moral defilement; without spot; not sullied or tarnished; incorrupt; undebased by moral depravity; holy. Chaste; as a pure virgin.

Is Purity common in society today?

Do you see purity increasing or decreasing in our nation?

Where do we see impurity today?

More than four in 10 Americans (43%) now say pornography is morally acceptable, a seven-percentage-point increase from last year. (Gallup, June 2018)

The use of filters by parents has not worked. In 2005 Pew Research found 54% usage of filters; in 2016 it was 39% with just 16% on mobile devices.

The average age of first exposure to pornography is 11 (Randel and Sanchez, "Huffington Post" - 2016).

"children under 10 now account for 22% of online porn consumption under 18" (British Journal of School Nursing.)

Almost half (46%) of teenagers say "sending sexual or naked photos or videos is part of everyday life for teenagers nowadays."

In 2016, people watched 4.6 billion hours (92 billion videos) of pornography at just one website which is an average of 12.5 videos for every person on earth.

Significance: So many people are viewing so much porn today that it is really impossible to tabulate.

Psalm 44: 21(NIV)

would not God have discovered it, since he knows the secrets of the heart?

Jeremiah 16: 17(NIV)

My eyes are on all their ways; they are not hidden from me, nor is their sin concealed from my eyes.

Seven ways we can develop a clean and pure heart in a world of filth and impurity

How to Develop a Pure Heart

1. Confess and forsake all sin, including private sin

Go into a private place and with an on your face, on your knees confession renounce any sins that are secret saying them out loud to God in repentance.

Be specific, if there are patterns of sin in your private, secret life that nobody knows about, you bring those before the Lord, confess and repent of those things.

Matthew 6: 11-12(NIV)

Give us today our daily bread.

And forgive us our debts,

as we also have forgiven our debtors.

1 John 1: 9 (NIV)

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.

1 Corinthians 10: 13(NIV)

No temptation has overtaken you except what is common to mankind. And God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can endure it.

How to Develop a Pure Heart

- 1. Confess and forsake all sin, including private sin
- 2. Saturate your mind and heart with the Word of God

The output of your life is in direct proportion to the intake of Scriptural Truth, the honest heart-felt intake. So get out the junk and disease by confessing and forsaking the sin and then fill your heart with the Word of God.

Philippians 4: 8(NIV)

Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy think about such things.

Psalm 119: 11(NIV)

I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.

Ephesians 5: 25-27(NIV)

Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word

"Watch and pray so that you will not fall into temptation. The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak."

And pray in the Spirit on all occasions with all kinds of prayers and requests. With this in mind, be alert and always keep on praying for all the Lord's people.

Sin is a highly contagious and deadly disease of the soul. Watch who you are around, what you are looking at and what you are absorbing into your mind.

Psalm 101: 3 (NLT)

I will refuse to look at anything vile and vulgar.

Job 31: 1(NIV)

"I made a covenant with my eyes not to look lustfully at a young woman.

Ezekiel 8: 12 (ESV)

Then he said to me, "Son of man, have you seen what the elders of the house of Israel are doing in the dark, each in his room of pictures? For they say, 'The LORD does not see us, the LORD has forsaken the land."

Genesis 19: 4-5 (NIV)

Before they had gone to bed, all the men from every part of the city of Sodom—both young and old—surrounded the house. They called to Lot, "Where are the men who came to you tonight? Bring them out to us so that we can have sex with them."

How to Develop a Pure Heart

- 1. Confess and forsake all sin, including hidden sin

Don't be deceived into thinking that you can just look or play with sin because sin cultivates evil thoughts in your heart which impacts your life and will manifest itself in sin and perhaps even death, so you have to win the battle inside.

2 Corinthians 10:5 (NIV)

We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ

James 1: 14-15 (NIV)

but each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed. Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death

- 6. Guard your memory

Proverbs 4: 23 (NIV)

Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.

Young people- as time passes you are filling up your memory bank with your life experiences and satan is really good at recycling the enjoyment of sin, but not the pain it caused, and making very vivid memories to entice you to sin again.

Ezekiel 23: 19 (NIV)




Pure Hearts


Question
