Why do I study God's Word?

We need to hear God's Word, not just read it...

We should prepare ourselves appropriately to hear God's Word when you read it.

Why and how do we do this?

Seven Reasons why we MUST Read God's Word

1. It is God's voice speaking to us. The Bible is literally "God-Breathed".

2 Timothy 3:16-17

2. It is our life instruction manual, provided to teach/instruct us... so that we might have hope.

Romans 15:4

It answers life's big questions like: Why am I here? Where did I come from? Where do I go after this life? Why is this life so hard? How can I have a successful marriage, be a good friend, a good parent, a good employee, a good leader, a good son or daughter? How can I have eternal life?

3. It is our weapon against satan. The sword of the Spirit is the armor of God's only offensive weapon.
