



## Daniel 11: 25(NLT)

*Then he will stir up his courage and raise a great army against the king of the south. The king of the south will go to battle with a mighty army, but to no avail, for there will be plots against him.*

# Daniel 11: 27(NLT)

*His own household will  
cause his downfall. His  
army will be swept away,  
and many will be killed.*

History tells us that Egypt lost because the counselors of the Egyptian king betrayed him. His trusted counselors, the members of his own household, had plotted to turn against him.

## Daniel 11: 28(NLT)

*“The king of the north will then return home with great riches. On the way he will set himself against the people of the holy covenant, doing much damage before continuing his journey.*”

## Daniel 11: 29-30(NLT)

*Then at the appointed time he will once again invade the south, but this time the result will be different. For warships from western coastlands will scare him off, and he will withdraw and return home.*

By now the Egyptians are so sick of Antiochus Epiphanes, that they ask Rome to send in a fleet. And so they do and they come against Antiochus.

He is angered and returns because he can't do anything against Egypt because of the Roman navy that he fears.

## Daniel 11: 30(NLT)

*But he will vent his anger  
against the people of the  
holy covenant and reward  
those who forsake the  
covenant.*

# Daniel 11: 31(NLT)

*His army will take over the Temple fortress, pollute the sanctuary, put a stop to the daily sacrifices, and set up the sacrilegious object that causes desecration.*

## Daniel 11: 32(NLT)

*He will flatter and win over those who have violated the covenant. But the people who know their God will be strong and will resist him.*

# Daniel 11: 33(NLT)

*Wise leaders will give instruction to many, but these teachers will die by fire and sword, or they will be jailed and robbed.*

In the end Antiochus had killed 80,000 Jews and sold 40,000 more into slavery, plundered the temple and dedicated it to his idols, he spread the fluids from a pig that he slaughtered on the altar and spread the fluids all through the temple,

he forced pork down the throats of the priests, and only allowed the worship of zeus and other false gods in the temple and he established prostitution in the temple chambers thereby turning God's temple into a brothel.

## Daniel 11: 34-35(NLT)

*During these persecutions, little help will arrive, and many who join them will not be sincere. And some of the wise will fall victim to persecution. In this way, they will be refined and cleansed and made pure until the time of the end, for the appointed time is still to come.*

Please pay close attention here. We have just jumped to the end of time, to the time of the antichrist. Up to this point, the prophecy has dealt with history past. Now we come to a different scene, history future, the time of the end. I believe this because of three reasons:

1) Both verses 35 and 40 of Daniel references "*the time of the end*" which indicate a future last-days point.

2) Chapter 10 verse 14 says *"I have come to give you an understanding of what will happen to your people in the latter days"* So, from the very beginning, the prophecy was said to stretch much further than just the Persian-Greek times.

3) We can follow with absolute accuracy every detail of the prophecy up to verse 35. But after that, we have no historical data that can at all relate to what happens from verse 36 to 45. Certainly not in the life of Antiochus Epiphanes.

## Daniel 11: 36(NLT)

*The king will do as he pleases, exalting himself and claiming to be greater than every god, even blaspheming the God of gods. He will succeed, but only until the time of wrath is completed. For what has been determined will surely take place.*

## Daniel 11: 37(NLT)

*He will have no respect for the gods of his ancestors, or for the god loved by women, or for any other god, for he will boast that he is greater than them all.*

## Daniel 11: 37(NASB)

*He will show no regard for the gods of his fathers or for the desire of women, nor will he show regard for any other god; for he will magnify himself above them all.*

# Daniel 11: 37(KJV)

*Neither shall he regard the  
God of his fathers, nor the  
desire of women, nor  
regard any god: for he  
shall magnify himself  
above all.*

## Daniel 11: 38(NLT)

*Instead of these, he will worship the god of fortresses—a god his ancestors never knew—and lavish on him gold, silver, precious stones, and expensive gifts.*

In place of normal affection, he will place a perverted worship of military power. Chapter 7 verse 23 of Daniel, says that when he comes he will devour the whole earth, the final form of the Roman Empire, he will tread it down and break it in pieces.

He will have the intimidation of nuclear weapons and whatever else may be available at that time, such as biological or chemical weapons.

He will take all of his silver, all of his gold, all of the precious stones, all of the desirable things to build a war machine. A god whom his fathers knew not to honor.

## Daniel 11: 39(NLT)

*Claiming this foreign god's help, he will attack the strongest fortresses. He will honor those who submit to him, appointing them to positions of authority and dividing the land among them as their reward.*

God is telling us how the antichrist will operate. He is going to share the wealth with those who follow him and it's going to look so good to be on his side. You follow me and I'll give you the a share of the treasures and the rule of your land, but in the end he will rule over everything.
